

**REGULAR MEETING**

**February 9, 2021**

The Regular Meeting of the Jennings City Council was convened on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. in the Jennings City Council Chambers, 154 N. Main Street, Jennings, Louisiana with President Stephen VanHook presiding and a quorum present.

The Prayer was led by Ms. Simon and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Armentor.

It was moved by Mr. LeJeune, seconded by Ms. Simon and carried by unanimous yeas of voice vote to **APPROVE** the Minutes of the January 12, 2021 Regular Meeting.

Ordinance No. 1768 – an ordinance to authorize the City of Jennings to rezone the property of Carlton Soularie from C-1 to C-2; and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith. It was motioned by Mr. LeBlanc and seconded by Ms. Simon to adopt Ordinance No. 1768. Mayor Guinn stated there was no negative feedback received at City Hall and no reason to reject this rezoning. After no other public comment or questions, it was carried by unanimous yeas of roll call voice vote to **ADOPT** Ordinance No. 1768.
